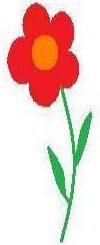
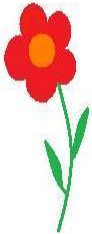


New Year - New Term!

Term 3 will be full of new and exciting learning activities in P1 Room 5!

You will be welcome to join us during our open afternoon on Thursday 26th January between 2 to 3 p.m. to visit the classroom during our lessons.



Language and Phonics

This term we will not have new sounds to learn and instead will be consolidating the sounds we already know, blending them together to help us in our reading and writing.

Every Tuesday we work in small groups on our phonemes (the smallest unit of sound) to help us build our language skills. We will also be exploring alphabetical order, tricky words and capital letters.

We have issued a Maths homework booklet.

We have handed out a sheet with two poems in Scots – your child can choose one and try to learn it by heart.
