

Literacy



- We have been practising our talking and listening skills throughout the year and have recently had a concentrated effort whilst doing our class talks on the subject of 'Scotland'. - We have continued to revise and consolidate previous phonic sounds and, for some, have moved onto new sounds and blends. We will continue to send home two reading books per week for you to read together with your child.
- We will continue to work on a variety of writing skills. The children are really getting the hang of this and are producing some excellent work.

Mathematics



- We have been working on addition and subtraction and have recently started to look more closely at Tens and Units, using chimney sums and doubling and halving.
- We will be looking at 'Money' this term and will have visitors in to do a workshop with the children.
- We are currently revising our 10 and 5 times tables.
- We are learning about 3D shape and symmetry and will be looking at position and directions in the next few weeks.


Health and Wellbeing
